

APCO 2017, APCO International's Annual Conference & Expo, is the premiere event for public safety communications professionals, from frontline telecommunicators to comm center managers to public safety communications equipment and services vendors. - ❖ The first APCO International Conference was held January 21, 1935 in St. Louis, Missouri, and APCO has held one annually since then.

- ❖ APCO 2016 attendees came from as far away as Australia, Japan and Dubai and represented a total of 22 countries.
